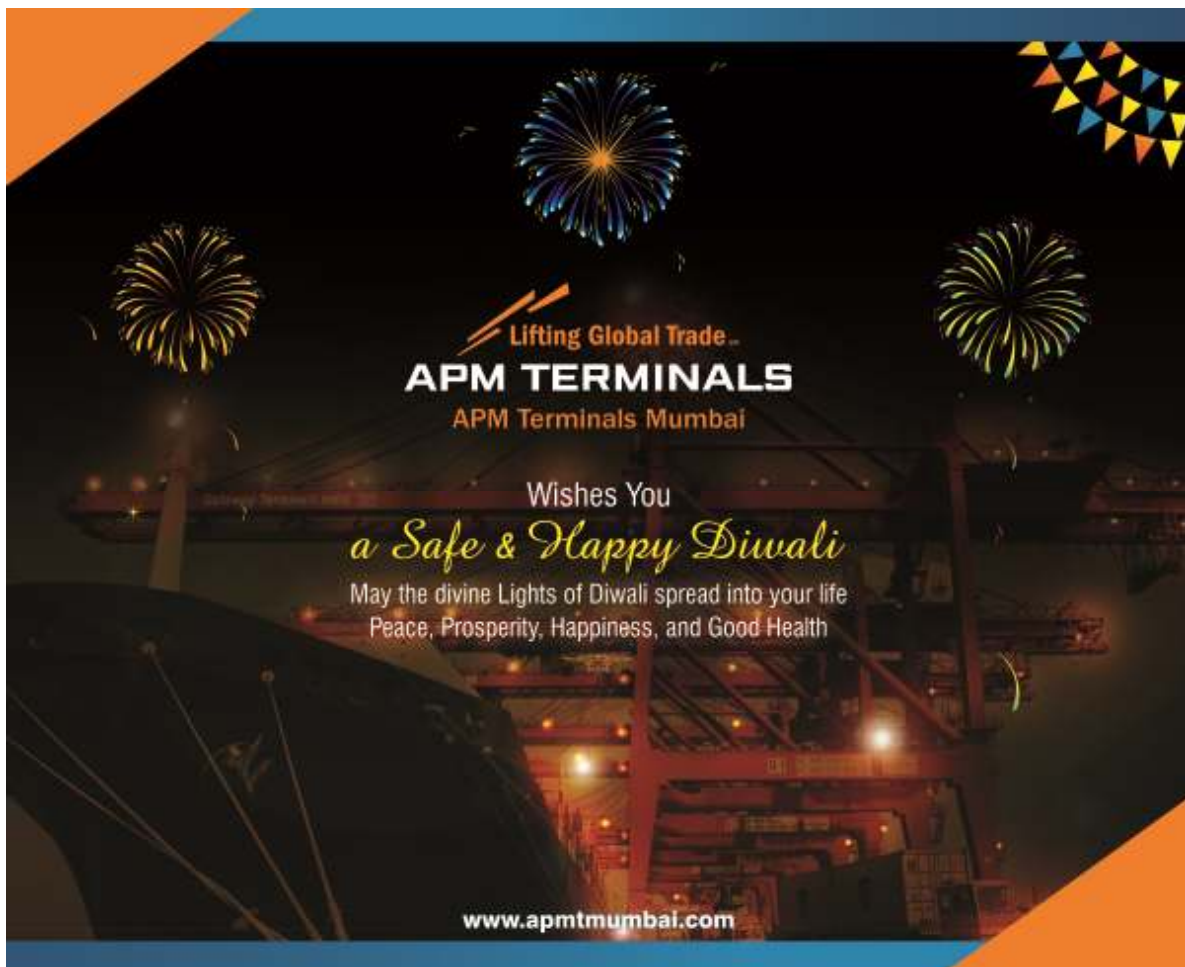

Towards a Safe Journey

APM Terminals Mumbai has launched a series of workshops since August 2014 for external tractor trailer (TT) drivers. The trainings are aimed at educating them on Safe Driving.

Considering the safety hazards associated with driving TTs, the terminal aims at inculcating a 'safe driving' attitude in the drivers. Among other safety factors, emphasis is placed on the compulsory wearing of seatbelts, terminal speed limit, prohibiting stepping out of the truck in terminal's yard except to lock or unlock a container with the TT, prohibiting standing below hanging loads (container/s) or driving of TT below a hanging load.

On successful completion of training, the driver receives a Safety Induction Card having a validity of three months. While entering the terminal's gates, the driver displays his Security Pass and the Safety Induction Card upon which he receives a Safety Flyer with basic "Do's and Don't's" on Safe driving. The Safety Induction Card however is issued only after the Trainer ascertains the level of understanding amongst the participants by examining them through random questions on the contents of the training imparted. On expiry of the card's validity the driver has to undergo the Safety Training again.

Through this initiative drivers are educated to drive safely not only within the terminal, but also their obligation towards safety of self and others outside terminals gates. The training is conducted by the terminal's Functional Managers in collaboration with its HSSE team. Till date 3000 external TT drivers have already been trained, and the terminal targets at training all drivers by end of 2014.

To make this a mandatory requirement, from November 2014 only those external TT drivers who have completed this training and are issued Safety Induction Cards will be allowed to carry out job transactions with APM Terminals Mumbai.

We humbly request you spread this message among all your stakeholders and partner with us in reaching out to as many external TT drivers as possible, which in turn would keep our lives and roads safe.
